The course is a thoroughly enjoyable and unforgettable golfing layout, immaculately maintained and reputed to be one of the best golf values in the Maritimes. With the recent improvements, 2001 will prove to be a banner year for this wonderful course.

The resort itself is an elegant and classic property that has hosted many sports celebrities over the years and has been rated by *Golf Ranking* magazine as a "Gold Medal" golf resort.





Highlands Links is also the first course in Atlantic Canada to hold the designation of "Certified Audubon Co-operative Sanctuary."

The beatuiful Bell Bay Golf Club, in the quaint village of Baddeck, Nova Scotia will play host to the 2001 Wayne Gretzky & Friends Invitational, July 1st and 2nd. Bell Bay sits high above Cape Breton's inland sea, the Bras d'Or Lakes, offering incredible panoramas from almost every hole. The course also overlooks Beinn Bhreagh, Alexander Graham Bell's beloved summer estate.

In 1998, Bell Bay was selected "Best New Canadian Golf Course" by *Golf Digest*. The routing of the course takes full advantage of the natural features of the land. Each hole has some distinctive element that gives it a memorable character and unique individuality.

Bell Bay is distinguished by its final four holes, which have been called one of the best finishing sequences anywhere. A strong candidate for the signature hole is the seventeenth par 3, "Banshee." The drastic elevation changes, ravine and wooded backdrop offer an illusion to the golfer's normal distance perception and it is easy to underhit the shot. The true signature hole though is saved for last. "Breadalbane" is one of the most scenic tee shots in golf. A sweeping panorama of cliffs and valleys is a backdrop to a hole that winds slightly uphill past a great gorge to the clubhouse.

Overall playability of the course is enhanced by the four distinct teeing areas, positioned to assure both challenge and enjoyment for players of all skill levels.






